

Career Search Results Improvements

The keyword search feature on the Explore Careers page now produces more effective results for career exploration and planning. This helps you find information if you're not sure about the exact title of a career.

Process:

1. Sign in to your account
2. Go to the **Career Planning** tab.
3. Click on the **Explore Careers** section.
4. Click into the **Search** box.
5. Enter a keyword or keywords.
6. Explore the enhanced results list.

Enhanced Results:

Single Keyword Search *Example:* *Scene*

- There is greater flexibility for words with more than one term.
- When entering the keyword "scene", only Career Profiles that include the whole word "scene", such as Crime Scene Technician, will appear.
- The keyword can appear in the title or on any page within the article including: career names, alternate names for careers, names of related or similar careers, and descriptions of the careers.

Multiple Keywords Search *Example:* *Crime Scene Technician*

- There is greater flexibility for words with more than one term. When entering "crime scene technician", your results will include any article that includes **all** of those whole words: crime+scene+technician.
- The keywords can appear in the title or on any page within the article.
- The keywords can appear in any order within the article.
- The keywords do NOT need to appear as an exact phrase.
